NERJA CAVE

Visiting the Cave is making a tour for the most important natural monument in Andalucia, declared as a Heritage monument, Bien de interés cultural in Spanish, since 2006, under the category of Geological archeological zone. The Nerja Cave is an Historic and artistic monument and Spanish geological site of interest of international relevance, thanks to the Geologic and Mineral Institute due to paleontological interest and geomorphological.

The **Nerja Cave**, also known as Natural Cathedral of Costa del Sol, is located to 150 metres from the coast, 200 metres above the level of the sea in the Sierra de Almijara. It is located to 5 minutes from Nerja city and located in the village of Maro. There are 35.000 m2 inside the Cave, being its horizontal longitude 700 metres.



MUSEO DE NERJA

The **Museum of Nerja** is a perfect complement to know more about not only culture but the history about Nerja and, of course, the secrets of the Cave.

It is included in the ticket for Nerja Cave.

This museum is a great place of local history, from Prehistory to nowadays, taking into account relevant moments.

As an important place of not only Nerja but all the Comarca de la Axarquía, this museum offers several events during all the year such as concerts, theatres, children's activities, book launches, recital of poems, etc.

Moreover, you could see temporary exhibitions in the show hall called Ana María Márquez.

You will find activities and special services for children and youngsters that perfectly complement scholar trips and didactic visits for primary and secondary schools.



VIRTUAL REALITY ROOM

The virtual reality room in Nerja Cave offers an immersive experience for their visitors. It complements the visit to the Cave, approaching -thanks to the new technologies- those galleries and secrets that are not possible to see during the visit.

It is a 360° visit that you can do with virtual reality glasses. A real complementary service that is included with your ticket for the Cave. It is the biggest virtual reality room of Europe where the film character Tadeo Jones welcomes you to this great adventure and helps understand it.

With this digital visit, we could learn more about how not only the Earth was formed but also the Nerja Cave and how the human being used to live inside it around 35.000 years ago simulating this kind of living in the first person.

It is like if the visitor, thanks to the virtual reality room and the involving sound, could be in that place at that time of the History. That's the way the visitor will learn more about the Prehistoric times in the Nerja Cave.

Furthermore, the Prehistoric rock paintings are shown in the video too. They are one of the most important ones in Europe. Moreover, geological and archeological curiosities and different scientific elements can be shown in the video.

Since May 2023 more than 300.000 people have visited it.









BOTANIC GARDEN.
DETUNDA-CUEVA DE NERJA,
WITH ACCESS FROM NERJA CAVE

Nerja Cave is located in the Parque Natural de las Sierras de Tejeda, Almijara y Alhama, you will see in the Botanical Garden Detunda-Cueva de Nerja species that are part of the southwestern area of Granada and eastern area of Malaga.

This garden is located in a terrain very different and diverse that is united with a great geological variety. Thanks to that, we will find there an important variety of species, with endemic species.

Walking through it, you will see a great sample of Mediterranean flora, the one that is adapted to different periods of dryness in, for example, summer times.

Furthermore, in this area you will find different traditional crops that are usual in this geological area.



VIRTUAL REALITY ROOM VISIT FOR PEOPLE WITH REDUCED MOBILITY

Children and youngsters with reduced mobility can, also, come to these scholar trips to Nerja Cave because we do have a great space: **the virtual reality room.**

Inside the Cave there's a circular visit where visitors need to be walking through 458 steps, so people with reduced mobility can not make it.

Wheel chairs are not allowed either inside the cave because of the steps.

Due to these things one of the most relevant points of FPSCN is to offer a cave more accessible and inclusive to everybody.

Moreover, the virtual reality room offers a virtual visit to the Nerja Cave. It is 10 minutes long.

In case you do have students with **reduced mobility**, please, do tell it in the email you send to book your visit.

This great experience will be an extra with the Virtual Reality room with Tadeo Jones that is a 12-minute video long. It is included in all the visits for children and youngsters.

There are orchids and odd species that shown us the great singularity that we can see here.

The botanic garden belongs to Junta de Andalucía. You can access to it through Nerja Cave behind the box office building.

It is open from 10.00 to 15.00 every day. Nevertheless, we kindly ask you to be informed before coming because the schedule times doesn't correspond to Nerja Cave, it does to Junta de Andalucía.


